Tasting Notes

Necessity may be the mother of invention but too much time on my hands may be the father...I do believe that there is still a lot of ground to be covered in the light bright young and fruitful red space. This year we pushed the earlier picking boundary to capture a more savoury fruit profile, with some beautiful natural acidity. Grenache dominant with Cinsault playing a lesser role and the addition of a splash of our unknown but thinking probably Bon Vedro this still has the darker fruit expression fruit with juicy dark/sour cherries and blood plums driving the up front with a herbal/savoury finish.

Colour: Deep crimson.

Aroma: Dark cherries, blood plums.

Palate: Starts sweet and juicy then finishes with some dry herbs and tea.

Summary: Fills a niche with aplomb.
